

SOLT/Equity Rates for Performers and Stage Management 2026 – 2029

- Year 1: a 6% increase to the equivalent 2025/2026 minima
- Year 2: a 5% increase to the equivalent 2026/2027 minima
- Year 3: rates to increase by the CPI figure published in March 2028 plus 0.5%, subject to the rise being no less than 2% and no greater than 5%

This is calculated by taking the £ difference between the Applicable Minimum Salaries of the relevant stage management roles minus the weekly Stage Management Responsibility payment. This is then divided by the number of shows per week to give a pro-rata Stage Management acting up performance payment.
